Hello Neighbors,

Hope you have all found it easy this year to turn in your membership renewal form. Filling out the form completely and returning it will ensure our records our updated. We accept them by mail, at the monthly meeting or if you see a patroller pass your home feel free to give them your membership paperwork. Your membership helps DANWA support crime prevention, educate our neighborhood about safety and security issues and the list continues. January alone, our police department called us out on two searches.

A prime example of your membership dues at work is DANWA is setting up an Escape School on March 8, 2004, at 7pm, for all of Del City with the help of Sunnylane Funeral Home. We had Mr. Dana Dobson at our February membership meeting giving details about the class. We have also invited all neighborhood watch groups to join us so we can educate parents and children about watch groups in their neighborhood. The escape school is for children 5 years old and above and teaches them ways to escape an abductor. I encourage all parents to bring your child to the class and get this information. The events in Florida in early February and our record here around Oklahoma City (another attempted abduction February 12<sup>th</sup>) shows a strong need for the class.
