From the Patrol Captain Desk



Reader's Corner:

D.J. writes—"What are the rules for riding electric scooters, non-powered scooters, bicycles or skating/rollerblading on roadways within Del City?"

City hall provided the following: **Section. 11-37. Use of roller skates, coasters, etc., on roadways**No person upon roller skates or riding in or by means of any scooter, toy wagon or vehicle or similar device shall go upon any roadway except while crossing a street on a crosswalk: and when so crossing, such person shall be granted all of the rights and shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to pedestrians.

An idea here would be to educate the rider of the scooter, skates, etc. of the rules of the road as well a pedestrian rules/courtesy, i.e. don't go down the middle of a street, don't cause an accident, obey the rules of the road, stop at a stop sign, etc., who has the right of way. Hopefully we teach our children to look both ways when crossing a road.

If there are further questions regarding this ordinance, please contact the Del City Police Department or City Hall of Del City.

P.T. writes "Disappointed in Del City"

For the second time in less than two weeks, my house has been vandalized by kids who are apparently being allowed to roam freely at night. I know it was kids, because they wrote "I hate you" and "You suck" and included my 6th graders name. I can't believe that parents allow their children of this age to run around the streets after midnight. I guess they don't care if someone kidnaps their children or if their children vandalize someone's house, or get shot while trespassing on someone's property in the middle of the night.

Also during this week, two 4th graders, 4TH GRADERS!!!, from the apartments entered my yard, stole a lawnmower and a weedwacker, and were apprehended by my wife. The parents of one was very apologetic and grounded their kid, but the other parent didn't care, and their attitude showed as the 4th grade kid called the cop names and used the F word.

I have had two bicycles stolen since I moved here a few years ago. One from our shed, and one locked in a bike rack at the school, someone threw a rock through our downstairs window, which could have caused serious damage to our twin two year olds. Some kids threw rocks and hit my three year old in the face while she was in our back yard. I've already had to put in a \$1500 security system, boarded up our back gate which kids were wandering into our yard through, put up barbed wire on our back fence, and am now spending plenty of money to try to fix the neighbor's fence as that is how the kids came in and stole our yard equipment. I also had to buy a new window. Now, I guess I will have to spend money on a surveillance system to catch whoever keeps vandalizing our house every weekend. I wish I could afford to move to a better neighborhood, but I can't. Not with all the money I have to spend replacing items and putting in security systems.

Up until now, we have been letting kids off with being talked to by the police. Now the time of forgiveness is gone. We are going to prosecute every infraction from now on. Maybe some of these kids need to spend a night in jail or be taken away to juvi for a while. How can we expect kids to grow up to be productive members of society when they do these types of crimes when they are young. If my 6th grader did these types of things (which he can't, because we don't let him out after 10), I would not hesitate to let him stew in a jail cell for awhile to think about what he had done.

An update on last night. One of the neighbors said that they saw a silver van come by and drop off about 15 kids. So someone of driving age (or, can be charged as an adult) was involved. Also, it would have had to have been someone in the neighborhood, because no one else knows my son's name. If you know someone with a large silver van, or see it in someone's driveway, please let me know so that I can have them arrested.
