

Hello Friends and Neighbors,

I am hoping you have read the crime statistics for the month of June and July. These are not very encouraging. Let's analyze them just a little. Both of these months school is not in session. We see young people out walking the streets at all hours. They appear to be out looking for something to do. The temperature is warm and it appears no one really knows where their children are. Do you know what your teenagers are doing right now?




