There have been business and individuals outside the DANWA area taking advantage of the free dump. Starting with the next free dump; **all those wishing to dump will be required to show a current water bill with an address within the DANWA area and a driver's license with a name matching the water bill.**

Here is a bit of information I want to pass along to everyone. Did you know that the Del City codes require that every house have an address displayed where it is plainly visible from the street? This helps the Police, Fire Department and Ambulance personnel find your house when needed. It also helps the Neighborhood Watch patrollers, especially at night, identify a house when needed. I know from experience that there are homes out there that the address is hard to find or cannot be found at night. So everyone please check your address display and make sure it is visible. A lot could depend on it some day.

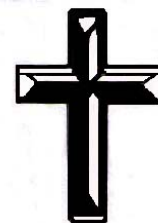

Grilled Corn on the Cob— - Whole ears of fresh sweet corn in their husks, butter or olive oil, salt and freshly ground pepper to taste, finely chopped fresh or dried herbs of choice such as parsley, oregano, marjoram, or thyme (optional, freshly grated parmesan cheese (optional). Place over hot coals, turning several times, until the kernels are tender and the outer husks have grill marks and are slightly blackened in places, about 10 or 15 minutes. Remove from the grill and allow to cool for 5 to 10 minutes before peeling the husks back and cutting them off with a knife. Allow 1 to 2 ears per person..
