Hello everyone,

We are now into March which is membership renewal month. I hope everyone received last month's newsletter with the return envelope. The renewal application will be in this month's newsletter again. So please fill out the application and get it sent in as all of last year's memberships (2007) end as of March 1st. It's only \$1.00 per month and most of the membership dues go to help the community and a small amount to purchase organization equipment and supplies. Nothing goes to the Patrollers, Base units or Officers as we are all volunteers and donate our time, gas and use of our vehicle.

The Free Dump is coming up in April. The exact dates have not been set as of this time; however it will probably be after mid-month. Look in next month's newsletter for the dates. So start thinking about what you need to get rid of for Free! If you still have yard debris, this is a good time to get rid of it without having to pay the dump to take it.

Some items from the City: If you haven't heard, Del City is getting a new 35 million dollar shopping center. The ground breaking will be this month if there are no delays. The new shopping center will be located at I-40 and Sooner Road in the empty field south of I-40. Scheduled to open sometime in 2010, it will have seven retail businesses, a hotel and five sit down restaurants which may include a Buffalo Wild Wings, Jonnies and Charleston's. It is expected to bring in 2.5 million dollars for the City in taxes. The Del City Police Department will increase by five Officers, two are already sworn in and three to be sworn in later. These were vacant positions the City is now filling. The Fire Department has one new Fireman and a new Rescue Vehicle.

It is with the greatest respect I provide the following information. In no way am I chastising anyone or making fun of anyone. In all my years of entering information for applications, I have heard of some real funny results. One instance would be when the application is looking for the spouse's name, someone might put in "yes". Believe it or not, applications are funny and sometimes the answer provided is correct but not what we are really asking for. So, we would appreciate your following these simple guidelines:

If you are **renewing** your membership, place a or 'X' in the space following **"RENEW"**.

If you are a **new member**, place a or 'X' in the space following **"REGISTER"**.

If you need any of the **"Burglar Beware"** stickers for your windows or cars, enter the number needed.

Address: where you live, not a post office box.

Name: your name or name of the head of household, Last name, first name, and Cell phone number.

Spouse name or other persons name living in the home, and their cell phone number.

Names of Children **living in your home with you.**

Your home phone number at the address you are registering and your **work phone** number.

Spouse or other person living at this address work phone.

Do you have a Storm cellar or safe room or both? Place a or 'X'.

Local emergency contact name and phone number. **LOCAL**, a neighbor, close friend, pastor, etc., please do not enter someone who lives out of state, they can't come help that quickly.

If you have any additional information or comments, please be kind. DANWA is comprised of Volunteers who are providing a service to our community and want to provide the utmost and best service we can.

And, to be a member, it is only \$12.00 a year, **just \$1.00 a month.**
