From your President:

Hello everyone,

Well here we are into June and that means the year is almost half over already. School is out now and that means that there will be more children out on the streets in our neighborhood during all hours of the day and evening. So please watch out for them while you go about your daily routine. It's also the time of the year when people take their trips and vacations. We are into what is called the critical 101 days of summer, when a lot of people are hurt or injured. So please be careful this summer.

Occasionally someone asks about the items on the bottom of the membership application. Most of the time the question is either what is "committee member" or "special projects"; or how do I volunteer for them. I thought I would take the time to give a short explanation of these items.

"Patrolling": This is obvious. Those are the people that patrol our neighborhood. You can contact the Patrol Captain about volunteering for this position. We can always use more patrollers if you can spare as little as a couple of hours a week.

"Block Captain": These are the individuals who deliver the news letters each month. The delivery areas are broken down into short sections of streets. We currently have one section open, on Del Aire. Contact any Officer for this.

"Committee Member": From time to time we have a need for a committee for such things as audits. These individuals are selected from the members attending the monthly meetings.

"Special Projects": This item gets asked about or circled the most. The watch group does things that require gathering information, costs or for planning for projects. These are things such as our Christmas project, Orval Ray Towers cookout, the get together like we just had and the Townsend school party, to mention a few. The individuals selected for these projects come from the members attending the monthly meetings; as they must be present to know what discussions have taken place, during the meeting, on the subject.

I would like to see more members get involved in the watch group by attending the monthly meetings. This is your neighborhood and your watch group. Invest one hour once a month in your watch group; that's all we ask. We need your input to know what your concerns are. We know that not all problems can be solved easily. Myself and the Patrol Captain do have a direct connection to the Police Chief and the City Manager through monthly meetings with them; so we can pass along information as needed and receive information from them. Our membership meeting is always the second Monday of the month at 7:00 PM and always at the building on the N.E. corner of 38th and Epperly; north of the church. I hope to see you there.
