From the DANWA President:

Hello everyone,

The crime stats for the month of February were down from January. This is something we like to see. The only category that did not go down was auto burglaries. I wrote about them last month so I will leave it at that. There were 6 residential burglaries also. Information from The Burglary Prevention Council and security experts say that most burglaries happen during 8 AM to 5 PM. Our crime stats pretty much reflect that. All six burglaries happened between 9 AM and 6 PM. The Burglary Prevention Council has some recommendations; some of which I'll pass along here.

*Keep all doors and windows closed and securely fastened when gone.

*Secure sliding glass doors with a metal rod or a piece of wood in the track and install vertical bolts.

*Always lock the door between the house and attached garage.

*Make your residence appear occupied by leaving on a radio or television when gone.

More items next month.

Just for your information. The City has hired three new Police Officer Candidates. All should go off for training in April. The bids for construction of the new Police department building should be back by April 15th and go before the City Council the last Council Meeting in April for acceptance. Construction should start 90 days after acceptance. Estimates are 18 months for completion. The Community Center, with the exception of the Library will close in January 2011 for 9 months to 1 year for remodeling. The remodeling will cost 1 to 1.5 million dollars.

It's that time of year again. The dates for the **Spring Free Dump** have been set. The dates will be **April 23rd, 24th & 25th**. The times will be **Friday 1 pm to 5 pm; Saturday 8 am to 5pm and Sunday 10 am to 5 pm**. We will be able to accept most items, **but we cannot take tires, chemicals, oil, or paint**. We can still take all types of batteries for recycling. **You will need to bring your Del City or Sooner water bill!**

The location for the Free dump has changed!! The Free Dump will now be held at the John Smith Soccer field on Sunnyslane Rd, ¾ of a mile north of the intersection of Sunnyslane and Reno Ave. And please, secure and cover your load for the trip as not to spread trash and items along Sunnyslane Rd.
