From the DANWA President:

Hello everyone,

The crime stats for the month of June for the most part remained low with the exception for vandalism's and larcenies. The rise in vandalism is probably due to some of the school age children starting to get bored and looking for more exciting things to do. The rise in larcenies is probably because more people are leaving their garage doors open due to the hot weather and leaving items sitting out unsecured. You may think that it will only take you a minute to go in the house and get a drink and cool off a little; but time has a way of slipping by. Lawn equipment sitting out unattended and open garage doors are very inviting to someone looking for items to steal. It only takes a few seconds to load up some of your items and be gone. You can believe me when I say that there are people driving the neighborhoods just looking for a quick score. Don't make it easy for them.

There has been information put out about people going door to door under the guise of selling things or offering, say a free alarm system survey and things of that nature. Please, if you did not call a company and request they come out; do not let them in your home to talk to you. There have been cases of people going door to door using this ruse so they can case your home for a robbery or burglary. With only a couple of exceptions, (general circulation newspapers and school children) anyone going door to door **must have a permit from the City of Del City on their person!** It cannot be "with their supervisor" or "in the car" or any other excuse. If anyone shows up at your home selling something and they do not have a permit, call the Del City Police and report them.

As a reminder, school will be starting soon, so be on the watch for those school zone lights and signs. I can guarantee that the Police Department will be watching very intently the first couple of weeks after school starts. Be Safe!

FIGHT THE BITE



Mosquito Control

Summer is almost here and so are the mosquitoes!!!!

West Nile virus can infect humans, birds, mosquitoes, horses and some mammals. It is spread through the bite of an infected mosquito, usually the Culex mosquito. These mosquitoes pick up the virus when they feed on infected birds. The virus is then transmitted to animals and humans when bitten by the mosquito.

Culex mosquitoes are most active in Oklahoma from July through October. Later this summer as the Culex mosquitoes become active, persons are advised to apply a DEET based mosquito repellent to their exposed skin and clothing. DEET contains the chemical N,N-diethyl-m-toluamide, which repels the mosquito, making the person unattractive for feeding.



Things you can do to FIGHT THE MOSQUITO BITE

- Take a very hard look at areas around the outside of your home that could breed mosquitoes.
- Drain outside items that hold water (tires, cans, etc.)
- Cover wading pools, boats and rain barrels when not in use
- Keep rain gutters clean
- Don't over water plants and lawns
- Change water in pet bowls and birdbaths often (at least weekly)
- Look for breeding areas in your neighborhood, such as abandoned pools; drainage ditches holding water, or other items that will hold water. Report these problem areas so they can be corrected, drained, or treated for mosquitoes.
