Hello everyone,

December turned out to be a good month statistics wise. With the exception of Larcenies, mostly affecting business, the numbers were very low. You can find those numbers elsewhere in the newsletter. Our general trend for the number of crimes over the last few months has been low with the exception, again, of Larcenies. After compiling the statics for the entire year of 2010; the entire year was better than previous years. Looking at the three items of most concern we see that Residential Burglaries went down from 71 in 2009 to 52 in 2010; Stolen Vehicles went down from 24 in 2009 to 23 in 2010 and Auto Burglary went down from 50 in 2009 to 22 in 2010. I can say without reservation that the Del Aire Neighborhood is better off than the other areas of Del City. We have our DANWA Patrolers to thank for that as well as those individuals living in our neighborhood that get involved in reporting suspicious activity in their area. A big THANKS to you all!

Coming up the 1st of March, our annual Membership renewal starts. As you may know, DANWA membership runs from the 1st of March thru the 28th of February the following year. On 1 March all memberships expire and must be renewed, no matter when paid. (With the exception of the renewals for 2011 that we have just begun receiving.) There will be a renewal form included with this newsletter with an envelope that is already addressed to DANWA. So, just fill in the information and send it in now while you're thinking of it and you're set for another year. It is only \$12.00 for the whole year! Membership dues are used to purchase any equipment that we need, or need to replace and fund the projects throughout the year that the group supports. As always, all Patrollers and Officers are **volunteers** and receive no compensation for their time or use of their vehicle. The Watch Group just provides the needed equipment. We can always use more Patrollers; so if you could spare even a couple of hours a week, we could sure use the help. 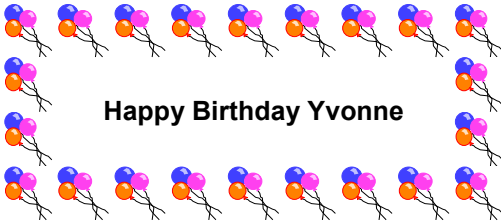

Not only by becoming a patroller but when you go out to pick up your daily paper in the morning or you leave your driveway in the morning, afternoon, or night. Do you look around to see if your neighbor's car is there or how about the two or three cars up or down your street that you see every day, are they still there or is there a DIFFERNET car or truck in their driveway? Does something look suspicious?

How about just looking out your window or door, do you see something strange or maybe an unfamiliar car driving up or down the street, how about some individual walking in the street, have you seen them before, do they look suspicious? Look around, do you see suspicious activity? **CALL THE COPS!** Don't wait, let the police determine if they are up to no good. Ask yourself what else can I do to help my neighbors....?

If you can only afford one hour a month, it will help. You don't have to participate 100% of your time. Just think of all the members we have; if one member took one hour out of their schedule for DANWA and there were one hundred members who took an hour, that is one hundred hours more this neighborhood could have **GOOD** eyes watching. If you feel it is an emergency, you can report directly to the police by using 911 on the phone.
