For the month of April, vandalisms and larcenies remained at the same amount as the prior month. The difference was with larcenies, which were mostly at businesses; 6 of the 9 reported. Residential Burglaries more than doubled for April, from 3 to 7, and as it has been lately, all happened during the day. The locations of 5 of the burglaries were within a block of one of our boundary streets. I assume that they are either driving off the main streets and staying close so they have an easy escape route or are walking the main streets and need to stay close to them or both. The other 2 instances were within one block of our main thru street, Vickie.

School is out now so we all need to be a lot more careful as we drive through the neighborhood. You never know when a child will come running into the street after something or riding a bicycle into your path because they are distracted.

This month, at the membership meeting, there will be a representative from the Fire Department to give a presentation about an upcoming Bond Election for Firefighting equipment, new outdoor warning equipment and other items. As usual, anyone and everyone are welcome to attend to learn about this bond issue. The date and time will be June 13th at 7:00 PM.

Summer vacation time is upon us. I hope that everyone will be as safe as possible while you go about weekend trips and summer vacations. The time between Memorial Day and Labor Day is known as the 101 Critical Days of Summer. During this time, more people are injured or killed than any other. So, Please Be Safe this summer!

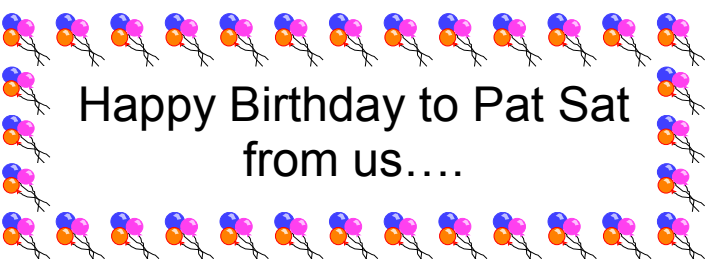

A group of volunteers, 2 master gardener candidates, 2 neighborhood watch members, 3 former residents of Del City, worked the morning of April 30 digging holes, planting plants, and mulching. The beds are now in good shape for all to enjoy as they pass by during the spring and summer seasons.

Last month we participated in the districts Camp-o-Ree at Choctaw Park in Choctaw. This year each Troop was to teach a scouting merit badge.
