July was a really good month for the DANWA area as far as the crime stats go. There were 0 residential burglaries, 1 auto burglary, 1 stolen vehicle and 4 larcenies (not counting apartments and businesses that we do not patrol). Totals city wide were, <u>40</u> residential burglaries, 10 auto burglaries, 12 stolen vehicles and 51 larcenies (counting apartments and businesses). Some upcoming events to be aware of: At our September meeting, there will be a representative from the Del Quest program to talk about this program for High School Junior's. Storm water Runoff Becomes Someone's Drinking Water

Storm water runoff will become someone's drinking water after it travels through the drainage system into the creeks and ultimately into lakes. The elimination of illicit discharges is key to maintaining a quality water source now and for future generations. During the summer months grass clippings and fertilizer are problems. During the winter salt from snow removal is a problem. The major pollutants to runoff are always oils and grease, trash, plastic bottles, Styrofoam cups, cigarette butts and trash.
