Hello everyone,

Just before I wrote this article I heard on the news that the Fire Chief of Nichols Hills was shot and killed in his home during a home invasion. Supposedly the person that committed the shooting entered the home through an unlocked side garage door and unlocked back entry door into the house. I have written before about keeping the door between the garage and the house locked when the garage door is open or while the outside entry door is open. The motive for the shooting is unknown at this time; it could have been to burglarize the house and were surprised to find someone home. We had a burglary in our area a couple of years back where the intruders were surprised by the resident and shot and killed her. My wife and I keep all outside doors locked when we are inside. That may have been a good thing; as a couple of weeks ago my wife looked out the patio door into the back yard and saw a person with a pulled up hooded sweat shirt in our back yard. Mind you know, my back yard is surrounded by a six foot stockade fence and all gates are padlocked so he had to climb over the fence. When noticed he ran and climbed back over the fence. It is in my opinion, "better to be safe than sorry". (since this initial writing, the Fire Chief's wife has been arrested, accused of the murder and is in custody. However, the scenario is still very true and a real possibility. Don't hesitate to lock doors and windows).

Along with keeping the doors locked is this; A couple of days ago I received a call from one of our members. A senior lady that lives alone called and told me of this incident. She said that a person knocked on her door and said he had some leftover material from another job and noticed she had cracks in her driveway. He said he would fill the cracks for free so she agreed. Shortly after starting the job, the man told her that he needed to go inside her home to set down. She told him he could set down outside but he insisted he needed to go inside. After again refusing to let the man in her home he left. (Without finishing) This member did the absolute right thing by refusing to let this person in her home. I'm sure that his motives were not good. I only wish that she had called the police as soon as it happened and maybe they could have found and questioned this (I'm going to be nice) person. Never let anyone and I mean anyone into your home that you do not know unless you have arranged the visit; such as carpet cleaning, appliance repair, delivery, etc. I have read several times about people letting someone they did not know into their home, to use the phone, get a drink, use the bathroom, etc. only to find their purse or other valuables missing after this person left.
