Hello everyone,

February was another great month crime statics wise. For the residences we only saw 1 residential burglary, 1 stolen vehicle, 2 larcenies, 2 vandalism and 2 prowlers. With summer coming up, I do not expect the numbers to stay this low but we will work towards that end. As usual, a complete breakdown of the statistics can be found elsewhere in the newsletter. With the return of the warm weather, we usually see an increase in crime as people tend to leave doors and windows open in our cars and homes. We also tend to leave more things unsecured and unwatched in our yards. So please keep that in mind as you go about your daily routines.

Another thing to keep in mind is that it will soon be the storm season. Every family needs to have a plan that works for you. It is recommended to have a planned meeting place outside your home area in case of a disaster. I know from experience that you may not be able to get to your home after a storm hits if you are away at work or the kids are in school. Usually an area gets closed down and no one can get in; but those in will be sent out. Cell phones often will not work due to downed towers and very high usage so plan your meeting place in advance. You may also want to have a secure place to keep copies of birth certificates, (especially if born out of state), marriage licenses and other important documents as these may be needed and hard to quickly replace. So now is the time to prepare a plan or review a previous plan.

Some upcoming events to make note of are; the new Del City Police Department and Municipal Court is scheduled for move in on April 30<sup>th</sup>, but no word on the official open house date. The annual Shriners and Armed Forces Day Parade will be held on May 19<sup>th</sup>, following the usual route. Bring your lawn chair, your flag and come join us there.
