

Some of these people are pioneers of space; others in music, business or scientific innovation. Some have fought battles far afield; others, closer to home. But all of these legends share one thing in common: They've relied on Boy Scout and Eagle Scout training to help them lead inspiring lives. Hats off to some of the most prestigious Scouts:

EAGLE SCOUTS

Neil Armstrong: First human to set foot on the Moon; astronaut, test pilot and naval aviator; flew on the Gem-

ini 8 and Apollo 11 missions William Bennett: Former U.S. Secretary of Education Michael Bloomberg: Current Mayor of New York City

William C. DeVries, MD: Transplanted first artificial heart Arthur Eldred: First Eagle Scout Philo Farnsworth: inventor and Gerald R. Ford, Jr.: 38th U.S. President [Gold Eagle] patented the television Steve Fossett: Adventurer, president of the National Eagle Scouts Association. Still missing after his plane crashed in the Nevada desert. [Louis Freeh: Former director of Robert M. Gates: current U.S. Secretary and former Director of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) liam "Green Bar Bill" Hillcourt: Danish Knight-Scout said to be the father of American Scouting [Gold Eagle] L. Ron Hubbard: Author of Dianetics; founder of Scientology Larry Kellner: CEO of Continental Airlines John F. Kennedy: 35th U.S. president Alfred Kinsey: Insect biologist, human behavior researcher James Lovell: Astronaut; flew on missions Gemini 7, Gemini 12, Apollo J. Willard Marriott, Jr: President, Marriott Corpora-8 and Apollo 13; former president of National Eagle Scout Association Jim Mora: Legendary NFL coach Michael Moore: Author, Oscar-nominated documentary filmmaker Ross Perot: Businessman, former presidential candidate Mitchell Paige: Marine Corps hero who was awarded the Medal of Honor for his actions during the Battle of Guadalcanal; also walked 200 miles to enlist in Marines on his 18th birthday Jim Rogers: CEO of Kampgrounds of America (KOA) Donald Rumsfeld: Former United States Secretary of Defense, former representative and ambassador to NATO [Gold Eagle] Brig. Gen. Robert Scott, Jr.: World War II Flying Tigers Ace

Stephen Spielberg: Top film director; made a movie of his troop while getting a photography Merit Badge [Gold Eagle] Richard H. Truly: Retired Navy vice admiral and astronaut; flew on shuttle missions STS-2 and STS-8; first former astronaut to head NASA

STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION REMINDERS

During the summer months there are some easy ways to reduce the amount of pollutants that enter our streams and creeks through storm water runoff.

Closely follow the instructions on any chemicals that are used on lawns. If you are instructed to water the lawn within a certain period of time, do that, rather than allowing rain to wash the chemicals in to storm drains.

Grass clippings should not be allowed to go down the storm drain.

Grass clippings, leaves or other organic items can never be put directly in creeks or drainage channels.

Wash your car on the yard the dirt and soapy water will be soaked into the ground and not go into the storm drain. An even better method is to use a car wash.

Recycle used oil at Public Works – 671-2874 and dispose of household hazardus waste by calling 739-1049

If you notice anyone dumping anything into the storm water system, contact the Code Enforcement Hotline 670-7379 or Public Works at 671-2874.

Little known tip regarding your grass clippings, especially if you fertilize—by returning the clippings to your lawn, the fertilizer in the clippings will continue working on your lawn and the grass will slowly work itself back in the yard as thatch which will eventually turn into dirt.
