From the DANWA President:

Hello everyone,

For the month of September there was only 1 reported residential burglary and it was unfounded so essentially there were none. Larcenies were also down with just 2 being non-business related; however auto burglaries and stolen vehicles were up with vandalisms remaining the same. We have had a rash of graffiti in the area on stop signs, utility boxes and fences. We were able to get some of the graffiti covered up by the utility companies and some more by a member that has volunteered to paint over such stuff. We thank them for their effort.

Here is an example of why I recommend keeping your doors locked when home. From Del City PD: Officers responded to a home invasion on SE 11th St., the victim stated that while she was in her room, suspects entered her house through the unlocked front door and went to her room and hit her with a black pistol. A fight occurred and she received multiple hits to the head. A second suspect made contact with another female upstairs and pointed a weapon at her. The first victims' son was told to sit down and shut up. Both suspects then fought with the victim until they left. The victim could not find her billfold with her ID and cash after they left. These victims were lucky, it could have been a lot worse.

Please take note of this from our Community Policing Officer, Sergeant Wofford: There were a couple of robberies recently that are probably related to the ones that were on the news in OKC. Late on a Friday night a female pulls up to a house, parking in the street, and as soon as she exits the vehicle she is approached by a group of 4-5 people, described as black race with one being female. One of the criminals pointed a gun at her while they robbed her of items. A few hours later the same thing happened a short distance away, same group description and with the weapon. This time they battered the victim while robbing them. It is believed they left in a blue or dark colored sedan. Both of these happened in Hartsdel but this could happen in any of our neighborhoods, so we need to be extra vigilant when we are exiting our car. If you arrive home and something doesn't feel right or you see someone nearby that doesn't belong there **Do Not** get out of your car. Drive away and call the Police, they will check it out for you. Without going into much detail I know the detectives are on this hard and fast and are making progress.

This is very good advice that I hope everyone heeds and it may also help catch these individuals.

Information to pass along: Del City now has a "Safe Trip For Scripts" program. There is a now a **white** container, which looks like a postal mail box, in the lobby of the Police Department. This box is clearly marked for this purpose. Citizens can bring in unwanted prescription drugs for proper disposal. It cannot however be used for needles, glass bottles or inhalers. It is accessible without the need to contact an Officer but you may contact any personnel if you need assistance. More **important** information to pass along! As of November 1st, the Open Carry law goes into effect. Please be aware of this. As of that date, persons with a **concealed carry permit** will be able to **openly carry a weapon**! Also, property owners will be allowed to **openly carry a weapon** on their property **without** a concealed carry permit. So please don't panic if you see someone carrying a weapon after this date. It will probably be a novelty for a while and some people will exercise their rights, but after the new wears off hopefully things will return to normal. If you have any issues or concerns, call the Del City Police. Be Safe!

Tips on using 911

When do I call 911?

Dial 911 to report an emergency or to pass on information to the police. If you are not sure, you can call 911 and they will determine if an emergency response is needed. If the 911 operator finds that your call does not meet the emergency guidelines, they will supply you with the telephone number to call the agency that can provide the services needed.

911 is a phone number that is used to get the police, fire department, or ambulance services to respond to anything that has to do with safety. It does not have to be an emergency in progress. You may for example, call 911 to report a burglary that was just discovered. When dialing 911 professionally trained call taker receives your call.

A 911 call is free of charge from any phone including a cellular phone. The dispatcher (the person answering the call) can quickly see where the caller is and can send emergency response to your location without the caller giving any information about where they are or what is happening. For example, if someone breaks into your home at night and you are afraid to talk out loud for fear that you might be heard, the dispatcher can send a police officer to your residence to check on your welfare without your even saying a word. **Please note, cell phone users must give the dispatcher their location.**
