Hello everyone,

The low September numbers for residential burglaries and larcenies did not continue during the month of October. There was a big increase in these crimes; from 1 & 5 to 7 & 17 respectively. All the residential burglaries as well as most of the larcenies took place during the day. Four of the burglaries were made from the back side of the house by prying a door (1) or breaking a window (3) to gain entry. Of the remaining three, 2 had no forced entry; 1 was domestic related, 1 was a family friend and in 1 the burglar was scared off by the occupant. There were two individuals caught and arrested for one of the crimes. I assume the criminals have started shopping early for the Holidays to avoid the rush this month. We all realize that during this time of the year most people have extra items around their homes that have been purchased for Christmas.

As the end of the year approaches, it is time for Neighborhood Watch to hold their Officer Elections. If anyone is interested in applying for one of the Officer positions, please contact Carol Standfill at 677-2333 to submit their nomination. The vote will be held at the December Membership meeting with the Officer's assuming duties at the January meeting.

I will just advise everyone to be aware of their surroundings while out shopping. Ladies watch over your purses and yourselves. And above all, do not make the criminals' job any easier!
