From the DANWA President:

Hello everyone,

Residential Burglaries for the month of January were up from December and from a year ago, with 6 being reported. That is 2 more than December and 4 more than January of last year. According to the Police Monthly Burglary Report, Del City wide burglaries dropped 47% from January of 2012. The reported burglaries for the DANWA area tripled for that period. In a departure from what has been happening, burglars hit residences throughout the area instead of around the perimeter of our area. Auto Burglaries were also up but all took place in the apartment complexes along Sooner Road. Del City Police contribute the city wide drop in burglaries to increased patrols in the residential areas. We will see what the future numbers show in the coming month's to see if the reduced numbers hold for the city.

Some other information pulled from the Monthly police Statistics; there were 4,163 calls for service by Officer in January. The Investigations Division was assigned 87 cases of which 47% were cleared and resulted in 19 arrests.

The Free Dumps start up again this month. You will find a list of dates and times for this year in the Newsletter. We will keep the list in the newsletter until the Free Dumps end. We have also tried to standardize the times, with all dumps being open at least the minimum hours of 1 to 5 on Friday, 9 to 5 on Saturday and 1 to 5 on Sunday. Be Safe!
