From the DANWA President:

Hello everyone,

The crime statistics for the month of February were very good. The overall numbers were about the same as usual; however most of the incidents took place at businesses or in the apartment complexes leaving the residential area in good shape. Any crime in our square mile is never good but realistically we will never have a time when there are not any crimes. Our goal is to keep the crimes as low as possible in the residential areas as we do not patrol the apartment complexes and our patrols have no effect on crimes at businesses.

A recent article in The Oklahoman (March 21, 2013) expressed concern by Police (in Midwest City) about the reluctance of people to call the Police when they witness crimes taking place in their neighborhoods. Multiple witnesses to a string of daylight burglaries throughout area failed to call Police while burglaries were happening. This applies everywhere! I cannot understand why anyone would not report a crime they were watching happen. You pick up the phone and dial 911 and tell the dispatcher what you see. Even if what you see just looks suspicious but you are not sure, call it in. According to Chief Taylor, there is nothing better for stopping crime than a nosey neighbor! Remember, the next time the criminal comes back; and they will come back, it might be your home they select!


