From the DANWA President:

Hello everyone,

The neighborhood had another good month in March with low crime rates. There were only two Residential Burglaries, two Stolen Vehicles and two Auto Burglaries. As the case has been, most of these took place around the perimeter of our area. The Del City Police have stepped up patrols throughout all the neighborhoods and I believe this has helped keep crime low and why criminals are staying near the major roads; for a quick getaway.

As a reminder, schools will be out about the 17th of March, putting more children playing in and near the streets during the day time. So, please exercise more caution when driving through the neighborhood because as you now, children sometimes ride or run into the street unexpectedly.

I have a couple items of note. The Police department has just hired another female police officer and she should be on the job soon. The cities surrounding Del City have all closed their public storm shelters, if they had one. Del City is now considering closing the storm shelter at City Hall. The reasons are many; such as liability concerns, the need to have to be ready to assist persons with any number of different handicaps and medical issues, people bring all types of pets, parking issues and cleanup after use to mention a few. If you rely on the city storm shelter, then you might want to start making alternative plans just in case the shelter closes. Storm season is upon us after all. Be safe!

Your utility/water bill and some information you need to know (as of 4/1/2013).

Ref: Lake Thunderbird. Due to the shortage of rain fall the lake is very low. It is so low in fact the pipe the we draw water from is only 5 feet from being able to draw any water from at all. The master conservancy board has reduced our water withdrawal right recently by 10% and now another 5%.

This is getting us in a very critical position which is why in an effort to protect the citizenry ability to consume water, we have approved the purchase and installation of two new water wells. This should put us in a much better situation. The drought fee is just a temporary fee used as a funding source that allows us to go forward with the purchase and installation. Based on the language that was implemented by the council and I, the temporary fee will drop off just as soon as we pay the bill off for the two wells.

Things you can do to help the visually impaired

Offer to drive them to their doctor's office, the grocery store, or any other location that is difficult for them to reach.

Offer to read to him or her on a regular basis.

Send the names and addresses of any blinded veterans you know in your community to the Blinded Veterans Association and tell them about the many services BVA offers.

What to do when you see a blind person

Don't assume that a blind person is unable to participate in certain activities. Let that person make the decision.

When you're leaving— - say so.

It's okay to use words like "look", "see", and "blind". Avoiding them may make a blind person self-conscious.

Caution a blind person about ascending or descending stairs, curbs, or obstacles.

Offer assistance when you see a blind person trying to cross a busy intersection, but don't be discouraged by a "No, thank you".

Offer to read newspapers, magazines, and other printed material for a blind person

Let blind people speak for themselves— - they don't need interpreters.

When speaking to a blind person, don't raise your voice. Remember, that person is blind not deaf.
