Hello everyone,

The crime statistics for May are about the same as last month but some lower than this month last year. As it has been for a while now, a majority of the homes burglarized have been around the parameter of our neighborhood just off the major streets. Information from the Police is that home owners and vigilant neighbors stopped several burglaries before any property could be taken from residents in other areas of Del City.

I mentioned last month about the public shelter possibly closing. The City manager has confirmed that the Del City shelter has been closed. Residents will no longer be sheltered there during storms. Everyone that has been relying on the Del City shelter should now make other arrangements for sheltering during a storm. Information I received says that there are no shelters in any of the communities around us either. Based on the recent storms in our area, being above ground in any building is not safe due to the strength of the storms we have been getting reticently.

If you attended the Armed Forces Day Parade last month you saw the two new Fire Rescue trucks that Del City purchased. They are really fine looking equipment vehicles. They will be receiving one more new fire truck soon. Be Safe!

STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION REMINDERS

During the summer months there are some easy ways to reduce the amount of pollutants that enter our streams and creeks through storm water runoff.

Closely follow the instructions on any chemicals that are used on lawns. If you are instructed to water the lawn within a certain period of time, do that, rather than allowing rain to wash the chemicals in to storm drains.

Grass clippings should not be allowed to go down the storm drain.

Grass clippings, leaves or other organic items can never be put directly in creeks or drainage channels.

Wash your car on the yard the dirt and soapy water will be soaked into the ground and not go into the storm drain. An even better method is to use a car wash.

Recycle used oil at Public Works – 671-2874 and dispose of household hazardous waste by calling 739-1049

If you notice anyone dumping anything into the storm water system, contact the Code Enforcement Hotline 670-7379 or Public Works at 671-2874.



Don't forget to place your newspapers, shredded papers (in a plastic bag) and other papers in the recycle bins at the northwest end of the Townsend parking lot. If the bins happen to be full, call the number on the bin and they will come pick them up.
