## From the DANWA President:

Hello everyone,

As anticipated, the crime stats show an increase in most categories for the month of November. Surprisingly though they exceeded last year's. On the residential burglaries; thieves targeted money, gaming systems and medications. Loss of medications, especially controlled drugs, can be a real problem. First is not having your medications to take, and it's not like you can just call the drug store and pick up more. In most cases it is very difficult to get controlled drugs replaced. Its' best to store your medications in a safe place that is not easily located; preferably in some type of secured lock box. This also has the advantage of protecting any children that may be in your home from accidentally ingesting them, thinking those colored pills are candy. And as a reminder, you can take your un-needed medications to the medication drop box in the lobby of the Police Department for disposal.

I have received information on a possible bond issue in early 2014. This possible bond issue is for the Mid-Del School System. The bond will be to pay for improvements in schools. Some of the items are: secure vestibules, electronic access, security cameras, security fencing around school perimeters, site lighting, roof repairs, buses, mobile laptop carts and software and network upgrades. Total amount needed is \$18.9 million, total available is \$7-10 million. There will be a property tax increase with this bond issue. The amount of increase depends on the valuation of your home. Examples given are: \$23 on a valuation of \$50,000; \$36 on \$75,000; \$50 on \$100,000. Send questions or comments to [pdeering@mid-del.net](mailto:pdeering@mid-del.net) or call 737-4461, ext 1233. **EARTHQUAKE SAFETY TIPS**

The recent earthquakes rumbling the state have been unnerving for many residents. Earthquakes can come at any time without warning so it's important to know what to do when one hits.

**OUTDOORS:** Stay there—Move away from buildings, streetlights and utility wires. The greatest danger exists at exits and alongside exterior walls.

**INDOORS:** Drop to the ground, take cover by getting under a sturdy table or other piece of furniture and hold on until the shaking stops. Stay away from windows, doors and walls and anything that could fall. If you are in bed, stay there. Stay inside until the shaking stops. Most injuries occur when people move to a different room or try to leave the building.

**VEHICLE:** Stop and stay in the vehicle. Avoid stopping near or under buildings, trees, overpasses and utility wires. Avoid driving on roads, bridges or ramps that might have been damaged by the earthquake.
