If they are blank, i.e. no phone numbers, no emergency contacts, we don't have any way of contacting you in an emergency situation like your garage door is open, or it appears someone has broken in the front door, maybe you have water gushing out somewhere around the house and you aren't there...... We don't know who to call! We might have last years membership application but that doesn't mean we have your latest phone number or your latest emergency contact; so be sure and put that information on the application. And as a reminder, the emergency phone number should be LOCAL not California, Maine, Florida......someone close by who might know where you are or maybe they have keys to your house and can secure it.....



# Missed Call From An Unknown Number? Better Business Bureau Warns Of the "One Ring" Scam

The Better Business Bureau is warning people who use cell phones about a simple "one ring" scam. It preys on curious minds and missed calls.

Scammers are using auto dialers to call thousands and thousands of cell phones. They let it ring once, and then when you look to see who called, some may call that number back and then you are automatically going to be charged \$29 additional on your phone bill. The calls cost \$20 up front and then \$9 for each additional minute.

The unknown number is usually from outside the United States, but they use the same country code (+1, which we share with Canada and almost all of the Caribbean nations, from the Bahamas to Jamaica), so it looks like a US number. And, while the FTC requires US numbers to inform the caller up front of additional charges, international numbers are not subject to that rule.

Protect yourself by not calling unknown numbers back. Or, if you feel that you need to call the number back, search the web first with the full number to find out where it originates and what person or company may have ties to the number. And lastly, check your phone bills carefully and call your cell phone carrier if you suspect anything.

#### Kolache recipe

Sweet dough for kolache(s), coffee cake, buns, doughnuts:

1 yeast cake or 2 pkgs. dry yeast

1 cup lukewarm milk

1/2 cup butter

2 eggs, well beaten

1/8 tsp. nutmeg

1 cup lukewarm water

2/3 cup sugar

1 tsp. salt

grated rind & juice of 1/2 lemon (optional)

7 cups (yikes!) flour or more

Pour water over yeast, add a little sugar, stir, and let stand about 10 minutes. Scald milk, cool to lukewarm. Cream together butter, sugar, & salt, add eggs & lemon (if used) & nutmeg. Add lukewarm milk to softened yeast & blend this liquid with 3 cups flour. Beat smooth, add butter mixture & enough flour to make a medium soft dough. Knead smooth, keep soft as can be handled without sticking, and let rise in cozy warm place until doubled in size. Roll out to about 1/4" thick, place on greased cookie sheet about 1-1/2" apart. Make indentation in middle. Fill with prepared fruit of your choice. Let rise until double in size and bake. (It doesn't give oven temp, but I would guess maybe 350°??)



Don't forget to place your used newspapers, shredded paper (preferably within a plastic bag) any old white paper in the Townsend Dumpsters for recycling, BUT REMEMBER, NO PHONEBOOKS OR CARD-BOARD. A reminder that the proceeds from these collections go to the school for the students.
