Attention!!!

The City of Del City is designated as a Municipal Storm Sewer System (MS4) community, permitted by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). As a MS4 community, we are required to monitor storm water runoff within the City. This includes illicit discharges—prohibited substance to the municipal storm sewer system that is not composed entirely of storm water. Some of these discharges include:

Grass in the Street

· Swimming Pool Water or Chemicals

· Yard Waste

- · Household Hazardous Waste and Chemical
- · Wrecked or discarded vehicles, appliances or equipment Tree limbs, leaves, etc.

The ultimate objective is to protect water quality and reduce the threat to humans and wildlife. To this end, should you see a violation, please contact Code Enforcement at 405-670-7379 or at codecomplaints@cityofdelcity.org. Your phone call can be anonymous.

Ladies and Gentlemen, this means DON'T dump your waste in the drainage ditches, DON'T let your grass, etc. collect or blow to the curbs or the MIDDLE of the street!!! If you are having someone mow your yard, remind them to not blow YOUR grass to the street!!!

Please help Del City to maintain that quality by following the city's guidelines.



Don't forget to recycle your newspapers, scrap papers, even shredded papers and old magazines. Look for that yellow and green container, there are several in our area.
