

If you have a Storm Shelter and desire to have it "marked" with GPS (Global Positioning System) technology and registered with the Del City Fire Department, contact one of the DANWA officers and they will arrange to come out with a GPS reader to provide you with the Latitude and Longitude numbers. These will also be provided to the Fire Department database list. Note this list is not published to the public but kept by the Fire Department for emergency services if needed, i.e. tornado that wipes the home off its foundation. Del City Fire Department Receives Specialized Smoke Detection Equipment for deaf or Hard of Hearing Individuals.

The Del City Fire Department, through a partnership with the Oklahoma Assistive Technology Foundation, Oklahoma ABLE Tech and Fire Protection Publications at Oklahoma State University, has received a limited quantity of free specialized smoke detection equipment available for deaf or hard of hearing individuals in the Del City community. The equipment includes smoke detectors, strobe lights and bed-shakers. The equipment will be installed in the homes of deaf or hard of hearing by trained Del City Firefighters who recently completed a 4 hour "Firefighters Serving People with disabilities" course, as well as a 2 hour "Smoke Alarm Installer Training" course.

For those interested in receiving the free equipment to be installed in the homes of an individual who is deaf or hard of hearing, contact Brandon Pursell at the Del City Fire Department at 671-2891 during normal weekday hours between 8am and 5pm, or leave a message for a return phone call. The free equipment is first-come first serve and is only available until the end of June.

USE THE "CLEAR" BUTTON

Using the "clear" button that is located on the buttons on the gas pump usually in the lower left hand side. People are getting really desperate due to the constantly rising gas prices. A friend just told me about something that happened to one of his coworkers. She used her credit/debit card to purchase gas at the pump (like most of us do). She received her receipt like normal however, when she checked her statement, there were two (2) \$50.00 charges added in addition to her purchase. Upon investigation, she found out that because she did not press the "clear" button on the pump, the employee inside the store was able to use her card to purchase his/her own gas! To keep this from happening, after you get your receipt, you must press the "CLEAR" button or your information will be stored until the next customer inserts their card.

(DANWA has not verified this information but it doesn't hurt to think about this on any machine that uses a credit card)
