### The best ways to stop Phone Spam, Scams and Robocalls.

If you are like me and get aggravated at phone calls who want to scam or cheat you out of your hard earned money, or call you on YOUR phone that you paid \$1000.00 for {FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE} trying to make money off you with their advertising!!!! I didn't purchase my phone for them to make money, I bought it for my convenience.

Most of us don't want scammers and telemarketers to bombard our phones we want the convenience of staying in contact with loved ones or friends. Here's tool and techniques to keep annoying and often malicious calls from interrupting your day.

**Block Spam Calls at the device level.** Both IOS and Android have basic settings to filter out unwanted calls.

- **For IOS 13 and higher**, go to Settings, Phone. Turn on "Silence Unknown Callers" feature
- **For Android**, there's a setting to enable "Filter spam calls", "Caller ID and spam protection" or "Block Unknown Callers" depending on the device.

**Add yourself to the registry.** It's not a perfect solution as Scam calls still slip through, but it doesn't hurt to get added to the Federal Trade Commissions National Do Not Call Registry. Their website lets you check if you've already registered your phone number, register it if you haven't and report unwanted calls that you've received.

**Block spam calls by caller.** If all else fails and a scam call gets through, you can block individual numbers manually to help prevent further harassment.

- **For IOS**, open the phone app and tap Recents. Then, tap on the info icon next to the number. Scroll down to tap "Block this Caller", "Block Contact."
- **For Android**, there an option to "Block Contact".
