A little side note about the "thin blue stripe" flag and the "thin red stripe" flags. Nothing is wrong with either flag in that they both represent respect for the Police and Fire fighters. It's like most anything else in life, you can make what you want out of it but the truth is blatantly obvious—both respect the departments as well as many of the civilians support too. Some people have blue lights on their driveways, some have green ones and some have red ones.....again, if you want to make something bad out of that, you are barking up the wrong tree.

In accordance with the U.S. Flag Code, the black and white flag with the blue stripe in the center is not technically an official version of the American flag.

The black and white flag with the blue stripe — which adopts the likeness of the American flag — does not violate the U.S. Flag Code. Enough said
