The heartwarming part is seeing what some of these kids do put in their cart, sure there is almost always a special toy, but even with children as young as 5 & 6 there are things like a new blouse for Mom, (Grandma), socks or gloves for Dad, shoes hats, & underwear for brother/sister, and often favorite food item. While the event is geared to be around the children, they understand the spirit of **giving** at Christmas. This year's SWAC will start off with breakfast at the Nazarene Church on Vickie Ave. at 7 am. There the children are paired up with their DCPD escort. Around 9 am, with lights flashing and sirens screaming, the procession heads to Wal-Mart. Let the fun begin. DANWA members were able help out SWAC this year in a big way:

**---- Article 7: Duties of Officers ----**

Section 1: *President*: The President shall preside at all general meetings of the Association and shall be an ex-officio member of all committees, excluding the Nominating and Auditing Committees.

Section 2: *Vice President*: The Vice President shall assist the President in performing the duties of that office and shall execute the duties of the President in his/her absence.

Section 3: *Secretary*: The Secretary shall keep accurate records and properly maintain any and all transactions between the Association and its members, to include preparation of the membership list.

Section 4: *Treasurer*: The Treasurer shall be responsible for the funds of the Association and shall pay all claims against the Association, approved by the members at the general meeting. The Treasurer shall keep accurate accounts so that the Association can be apprised of its financial condition at any time. The Treasurer shall ensure the financial data is provided to a tax preparer so it can be filed properly with the IRS. A written Treasurer's Report shall be given at all general meetings, including itemized expenditures over one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

Section 5: *Assistant Treasurer*: The Assistant Treasurer shall have the authority to sign all financial transactions and documents in the absence of the Treasurer. The Assistant Treasurer shall also assist the Treasurer in performing the duties of that office and shall execute the duties of the Treasurer in his/her absence.

Section 6: *Patrol Captain*: The nominee for Patrol Captain shall be taken from those active patrollers and/or base operators who are in good standing with the Association. The Patrol Captain shall:

- a) Be responsible for the neighborhood watch patrol.
- b) Oversee the training of all patrollers and base operators.
- c) Be responsible for all patrol equipment, to ensure that it is in proper working order.
- d) Be required to maintain a current inventory list.
- e) Work closely with the Del City Police and Fire Departments.

The patrol captain shall present a report of the patrol's activities at all general meetings.

IT IS A GUARANTEE YOUR VOTE WILL COUNT AT THE MEETING. COME ON OUT AND SEE.

A few reminders:

Even though we have had a freeze it is a great idea to unscrew your hoses from the outside spigots.

If your animals stay outside be sure to have water available and not let it ice over.

It is also advisable to have some kind of shelter for the outside animals so they don't get covered in snow, sleet or rain, even though they are suited for it.

Always remember if you are driving on ice or snow, that vehicle doesn't stop any faster because it is a FOUR WHEEL DRIVE — PLEASE DRIVE CAREFULLY AND FRIENDLY
