Greetings Friends and Neighbors

Just when we think we have the bulk trash issue figured out, the City throws an amendment into the plan (which you should be getting notice of with your Del City Utilities bill). You can still do the 2 free pickups per year, however, effective the first Monday of April, then the first Monday of May, and the first Monday of June, Del City Public Works will do a city-wide bulk trash pickup. There will NO charge to the resident and it does NOT count against your 2 annual free pickups. Regular restrictions apply, no batteries, no tires, no paint, and no hazardous materials. Ladies and Gentlemen:

There is a good possibility you don't know that **Del City has a bulk trash pickup!** As a **utilities/sanitation customer** you have two times a year for the **FREE** bulk trash pickup, not in the same month but throughout the year. If you exceed that limit or have more than one in a month, it will cost you an appropriate fee. Your timing in placing the trash on the curb is relevant and must be called in within a week. If you need assistance or are in question as to the purpose of this article please contact the Sanitation Department at (405)671-2873.

Note of consequence: The City of Del City Code Enforcement may leave a notice of violation regarding trash not being picked up or disposed of properly and if not resolved could result in a lien on your property.

Information we learned at the March General membership meeting: The City of Del City is going to provide a "clean sweep" for the residents beginning April and by ward designation. Ward 1 and Ward 3 are both in our area, see the last page of this issue for more information.

Clean Sweep



The City of Del City is rolling a "Clean Sweep" Initiative during the months of April, May, and June. This will offer bulk trash to be picked up by ward one time per month without any requests being made.

Step 1: Know your pickup week:

WARD 1 Pickup Weeks: April 7th, May 5th, and June 2nd.
 WARD 3 Pickup Weeks: April 21st, May 19th, and June 16th.

Step 2: Ensure items meet sanitation guidelines regarding size and unacceptable waste, which can be found on the city's website under the **Public Works > Bulk Trash** page and are not near any obstructions such as cars, trees, or low hanging lines.

Step 3: Items for pickup must be at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. on the Monday of pickup week to guarantee pickup. Because only one pickup attempt will be made, this is crucial that items are out on time!
