It's pretty obvious to me that a lot of people do not read the newsletter or pay attention to their property and surroundings. I have posted many remarks about grass height; stop and think about it, the taller it is the harder it is to mow later and harder to see the rodents that take place in those areas.

I continue to drive around and see trash bins side by side without space and you wonder why they didn't pick it up?? Separate them at least 3 feet apart so those long arms can get in between the bins.

Brush or downed trees in the front yard by the mailbox or over the water meter.....no, don't do that, another reason for it to not be picked up. Leave at least 4 ft space from your mailbox or water meter, etc.

Yes I know I'm being redundant but sometimes it takes two or three times for it to sink in that you need to abide by the guidelines set forth for city services.

Code enforcement: Friendly reminder to residents and property owners to keep lawns and vacant lots properly maintained by regularly mowing and removing weeds. Tall weeds and grass are considered a public nuisance under City ordinance and can attract pests, create fire hazards, and negatively impact neighborhood appearance. Working together to maintain our properties helps keep Del City safe, clean, and welcoming for everyone. Watch out for your neighbor and be a good neighbor by keeping your lawn mowed, trees trimmed and basic maintenance of your property. (yep, I said it again)

A reminder: Del City has signed an agreement with the City of Midwest City for safe disposal of unwanted or expired household hazardous waste. Drop-offs by appointment only.

Acceptable items: acid, bases, corrosive materials, aerosol cans, automotive fluids, batteries, fertilizers, pesticides and more. See midwestcityok.org for full list and details.
